## **Report on Promotion of Gender Equity and Facilities for Women**

The activities done by the college for promotion of gender equality during the academic year 2023-2024 are briefly reported: -

1. A popular talk on Women's Equality to celebrate **“Women's Equality Day”** was organized by Women Cell, Kampur College, supported by IQAC on 26<sup>th</sup> of August, 2023. Dr. Nalini Bora, HOD, Department of English, Kampur College delivered a motivational speech to inspire the girl students to move forward to create a better space and raise awareness about the rights of women in the society. A total of 55 students participated in the programme.
2. An awareness programme on **“Menstrual Health & Hygiene of Girl Child”** was organised to observe the **“International day of the Girl Child”** in Namghar of Kalaikhowa (Adopted Village of Kampur College) on 11<sup>th</sup> of October, 2023. A popular talk program on Menstrual Health of girls was held and Sanitary Napkins were distributed to the Girls. Total 44 girls participated in the programme.
3. National Cadet Corps (NCC) Unit of Kampur College celebrated **“National Women's Day”** by organizing a workshop to empower female students of our college and other institutions of surrounding area from 11 to 13<sup>th</sup> of February, 2024. Total 51 girls participated in the programme.
4. An awareness program on **“Breast Cancer”** was organized by Women Cell, Kampur College in collaboration with **“Dr. Bhabendra Nath Hazarika, Pushpa Hazarika Memorial Trust”** supported by IQAC, Kampur College on 9<sup>th</sup> of March, 2024, on the occasion of **“International Women's Day”** to aware about the symptoms and causes of breast cancer and how to get recovery from it. Total 56 students participated in the programme.
5. An awareness program on **“Mother's Health Care”** was organized jointly by Women Cell & Gender Sensitization and Internal Complaint Cell, supported by IQAC Kampur College on 14<sup>th</sup> of May, 2024 to celebrate the **“Mother's Day”** in Palashabari L.P. School (Adopted school of Kampur College) with the aim to create consciousness about the health-related issues of women in the locality and to maintain a balanced physical and mental wellbeing. Total 44 participants attended in the programme. Resource person Mrs. Riju Laskar, HOD of Geography and Mrs. Parul Bhuyan, HOD of Education delivered fruitful lectures on the topic and Dr. Saddam Hussain, Medical Officer enlightened with his valuable suggestions.
