Introduction

Hence, for the sake of financial security, students usually target for defense as well as paramilitary forces. Even couple of students have successfully passed the exams and joined in Police, CRPF, Indian Army, Assam Commando and so on. Considering the significance to ensure job security, the initiative “Thinking Beyond the Academia” is an essential step towards the students of Kampur College.

It is found that Kampur College is the only option of poor and economically backward students. Secondly, being a single stream College, having only Arts, the choice as well as competition among the students remained limited. Strategies

Seeing its importance, initially the College entrusted its responsibility upon a faculty member, later on a Cell named 'Students' Guidance and Career Counselling Cell' and NCC to utilize and reshape the young energetic blood.
