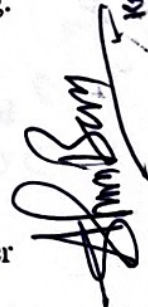

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Both Parties shall nominate coordinators for implementation of activities. Specific programmes may be undertaken through separate work plans. Each Party shall provide reasonable support for successful execution of approved activities.

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

This MoU does not create any financial obligation. Financial commitments, if any, shall be governed by separate written agreements approved by both Parties.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Intellectual Property Rights arising from collaborative activities shall be governed by mutually agreed terms and applicable laws, regulations and institutional policies.

CONFIDENTIALITY

Both Parties shall maintain confidentiality of proprietary, academic, administrative and research information exchanged under this MoU except where disclosure is required by law.

DURATION

This MoU shall remain valid for a period of three (03) years from the date of execution and may be renewed by mutual written consent.

REVIEW AND MONITORING

The Parties shall periodically review the progress of collaborative activities and may modify the scope of collaboration through written amendments.

TERMINATION

Either Party may terminate this MoU by providing one (01) months' prior written notice. Ongoing activities may continue until completion unless otherwise agreed.

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Any dispute arising out of the interpretation or implementation of this MoU shall be resolved amicably through mutual consultation. Failing such resolution, the matter shall be subject to the jurisdiction of competent courts in Assam.

LEGAL STATUS

This MoU represents the intentions of the Parties and does not create a legally enforceable partnership, agency, employment relationship or financial liability unless specifically agreed in writing.
